

Civic Activist and Founder of the <u>Do It Now! Movement</u>, Aleah Conlin leapt into action in the spring of 2020 when history repeated itself and an international shift began following the brutal murder by the police of George Floyd. The Do It Now! Movement was formed to unleash Aleah's passion for the push towards equality and her craving to create a rewrite of diversity within her community and the world.

Using anguish as an accelerant and her creative powers as a vehicle, Aleah produced the Do It Now! Movement's inaugural event a Virtual Juneteenth celebration on June 19th 2020. The 12 hour livestream reached over 750 people nationally, spread awareness of the holiday, showcased the talent of 35 Black artists, Black history and culture. Speakers included advocates for social justice and voter rights, State Senators and School Board Representatives. An original **Do It Now! 35 page Black Business Directory** was released. By the end of the Juneteenth celebration, the program raised \$5000 and donated to three different organizations fighting for social justice and rights in the US.

On August 8, 2020 the Do It Now! Movement live streamed Amplify CommUNITY! A collective of Black and Brown artists, performers, activists, speakers and musicians supported by educators of all races a/ethnicities and others in the community who raised their voices and highlighted their talent to shed light on education inequality. This multiaged student empowerment event uplifted its audience, while seeking solutions to end the vicious cycle of inequity fostered in disparate education systems that perpetuate dashed hopes and dreams in Black and Brown students. An original Do In Now! Culturally Relevant Books and Resources was released. Amplify CommUNITY! raised funds to donate 360 backpacks for students in need in Philadelphia.

Do It Now! Movement is a collective lead by Aleah Conlin that partners with <u>A Story for Change</u>, <u>EiTHER Podcast</u> and <u>Internet-Fabulous-TV</u> to create, promote and sponsor it's events that foster awareness and cooperation through inclusivity, social justice, and community outreach.

Aleah and her amazingly supportive husband, Greg, lives in Ambler, PA. She teach at Ancillae-Assupta Academy and at several dance studios.
